It doesn't move, it easily handles wet environments without change and has proved to be the perfect product for us."

The result: AMS Joinery found that Medite Tricoya machined cleanly to an impressively high standard. The chosen finish for the door was a black gloss polyester spray, which gave it a smooth gloss finish with no brush marks. Mr. Smith concluded, "It's an expensive product, but the value and benefits of Medite Tricoya save so many potential problems, including repair and re-manufacture. It is well worth it, both for us and our clients and we've already
